

Liebrecht VANBECKEVOORT

Liebrecht Vanbeckevoort born in 1984, is undoubtedly one of the greatest Belgian artists of his generation. He has studied under renown masters such as Jan Michiels, Menahem Pressler, Russell Sherman and Elissó Wirssaladze. He is currently a guest professor at LUCA School of Arts.

In 2007 he was a laureate of the Queen Elisabeth Competition. He has performed on highly reputed stages in Europe, Israel, China, South Africa, Canada and the United States.

The concertos for piano by Beethoven, Liszt and Rachmaninov feature prominently in his repertoire. In 2014 five full concertos for piano by Beethoven were programmed in his concerts. He has also recorded six CDs which include two concertos for piano by Liszt, a live recording of the third concerto for piano by Rachmaninov, soloist pieces by Mendelssohn and Schumann as well as chamber music by Mozart. He's a passionate chamber music player and can often be heard playing with the violinist Ning Kam, the pianist Severin von Eckardstein and the tenor Thomas Blondelle. He's also a member of the Roeland Hendrikx Ensemble. He has been highly successful playing in a duo with the jazz pianist Jef Neve.

For the 2016-2017 season promising productions have been scheduled; concerts in South Africa, China and in the United States with solo recitals of concertos by Beethoven, Brahms and Rachmaninov the recording of three new CDs including a first album with Ning Kam.

Liebrecht Vanbeckevoort has officially received the title of "Steinway Artist" and will participate in original creations by Guy-David. Liebrecht Vanbeckevoort is also the artistic director of the international summer festival « Klassiek Leeft Meesterlijk » in Knokke-Heist.
